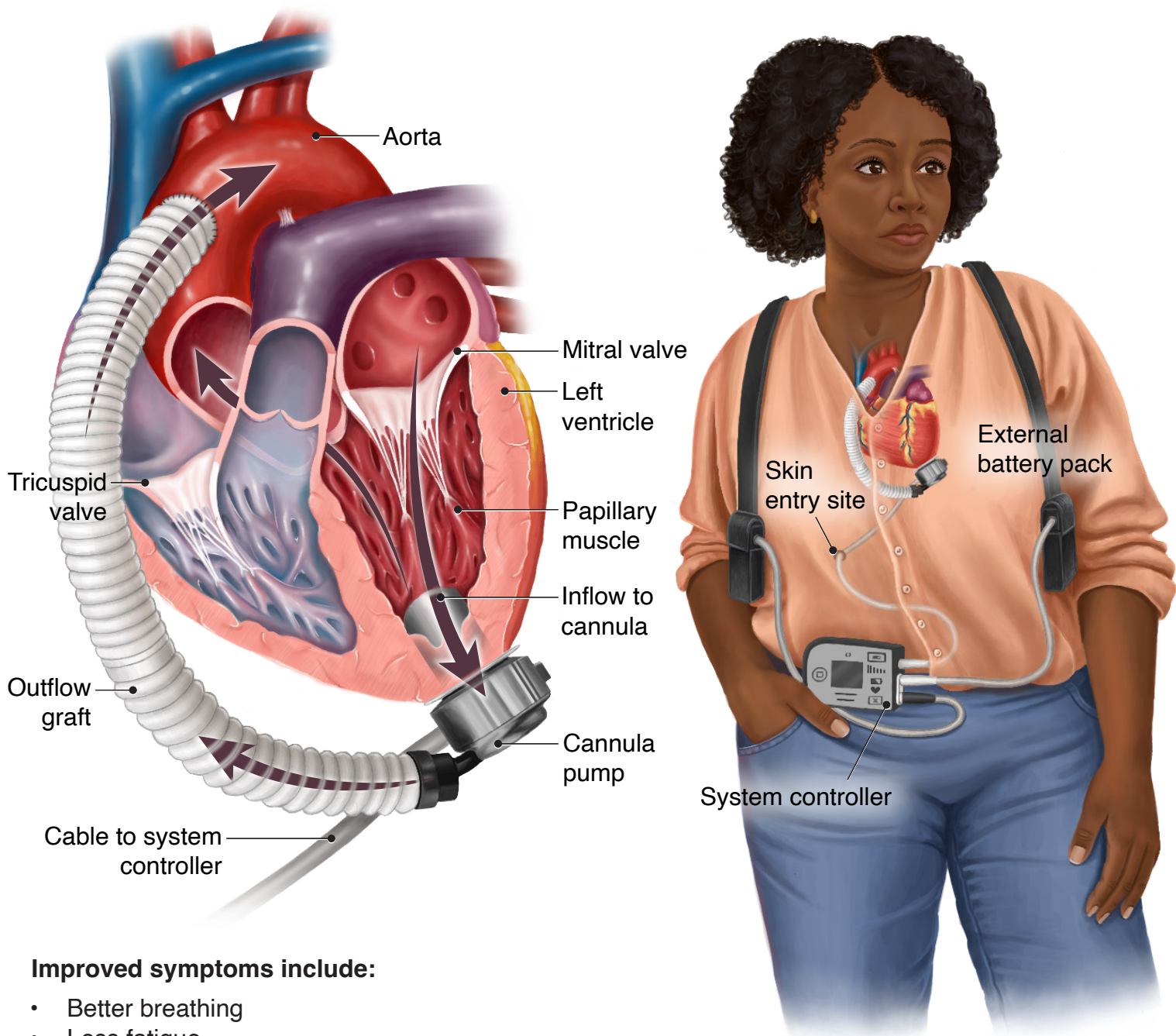


HEART DISEASE MITIGATED BY VENTRICULAR SUPPORT DEVICE
